City of La Verne Nomination Period Open for the March 7, 2017, General Municipal Election

Persons interested in running for the offices of City Council Member or Mayor for the City of La Verne in the upcoming March 7, 2017, General Municipal Election may obtain nomination papers and candidate guidelines from the City Clerk beginning Monday, November 14, 2016, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Paperwork is required to be submitted when the nomination period closes on December 12, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

The General Municipal Election will fill two seats on the City Council for four-year terms and the Mayor's seat for a two-year term. To be eligible to hold office as a City Councilmember, a person must be 18 years old and a registered voter residing within the boundaries of the City of La Verne.

All forms required for nomination and election to the City Council in the City of La Verne are furnished by and filed with the La Verne City Clerk. Appointments to obtain the nomination papers and candidate guidelines are highly recommended to ensure ample time to thoroughly review the filing requirements and answer any questions. The process takes approximately 30 minutes.
